



**Golf Program: "Amazing Buenos Aires & Jesuital Estancias"**  
(16 days/15 nights)

**Non Golfer Daily Itinerary**

**Day 01 – Buenos Aires:**

Reception at the airport and private transportation service to the chosen hotel with bilingual guide. In the afternoon, we will enjoy the **"Visit to the City"** excursion in a private service with a bilingual guide. **It includes Appetizer at Tortoni Café.** We will depart from **Mayo Square**, fundamental perimeter of Buenos Aires, to visit the Casa Rosada, the Cabildo (Town Hall), and the impressive neoclassic-style Metropolitan Cathedral with the Mausoleum of San Martín. We continue to **San Telmo**, site chosen by the "porteño" aristocracy until 1871, walking through its cobbled streets, stopping at the traditional Dorrego Square where visitors can buy from first-class antiques to second-hand magazines and records. The next stop is **Mayo Avenue**. It was inaugurated in 1894 and it joins Mayo Square with the Congress; on both sides, it has amazing buildings in Art Nouveau and Art Déco styles. It is mainly populated by Spanish immigrants who set up numerous cafes, restaurants, as well as the Avenida Theater. We will have an appetizer at the mythical Tortoni Cafe, traditionally frequented by artists and intellectual people; then, we will visit **La Boca**, neighborhood where most of the Italian immigrants arrived and settled down at the end of 19<sup>th</sup> century. We will be amazed at the zinc-sheet houses painted in bright colors, Caminito Street, and the football stadium Boca Juniors, Maradona´s sports cradle. We will visit **Puerto Madero**, the most modern and sophisticated neighborhood that originates from an urban project that started with the renovation of warehouses and sheds aiming at setting up exclusive houses, restaurant, hotels, and modern buildings. Next, we will move to **Retiro**, where the splendid San Martín Square can be found surrounded by elegant buildings reminiscent of the French Belle Époque such as the former Paz Palace, San Martín Palace, and the Plaza Hotel (Stop at the Monument for the Fallen on Falklands War). In **Recoleta**, we will visit Alvear Avenue where the principal fashion stores in the world are located. We will tour around Francia Square, one of the most beautiful parks of the city, the colonial Pilar Basilica, and the well-known Recoleta Cemetery where the most prominent Argentinean personalities rest, among them Eva Perón. **Palermo Chico:** Surrounded by the Palermo Forests, main green area of the city, it is the most exclusive and aristocratic neighborhoods of Buenos Aires. At night, **"Dinner and Tango Show with VIP Menu"** at the tango house chosen, **"Esquina Carlos Gardel"**, **"Gala Tango"**, **"La Ventana"**, **"Madero Tango"**, **"Piazzolla Tango"** or **"Viejo Almacén"**, including hotel/show/hotel private transportation service with bilingual guide. The famous nightlife of Buenos Aires offered to its own people and to those who visit the city features innumerable gastronomic and artistic options. You will enjoy the magic and the charm of Tango, the protagonist of the night! It includes **dinner with VIP Menu** with starter, main course, dessert, soda or mineral water, a bottle of wine per person, coffee or tea, a glass of champagne. Accommodation.

**Day 02 – Buenos Aires:**

Breakfast. After breakfast, **Shopping Time!** Buenos Aires is an ideal city to go shopping: Argentinian design is internationally known by its quality and innovation, and the exchange rate is incredibly good for visitors. After assessing your style and expectations, our bilingual tour guide will take us to the stores that best suit your style and needs. **Classic Shopping Tour:** This is a tour designed for demanding people. Our expert bilingual guide will take you to the most elegant and prestigious stores in town: not only will you enjoy the international brands you already know, but you will also discover the wonders of Argentinian design, which is nowadays experiencing an international boom. We will enjoy the "**Buenos Aires Nightlife**" excursion in private service with a bilingual guide specializing in Buenos Aires' History, Arts, and Architecture. This excursion will allow us to meet the illuminated city. We will depart from Mayo Square where we will admire Casa de Gobierno, Cabildo, and the Metropolitan Cathedral. Then, going up to Mayo Avenue, we will be amazed at the Congress building. We will tour around the area known as "Bajo" (down), which works as the financial center of Buenos Aires during the day and it has turned into the district of pubs at night. Then we will visit San Martín Square, and in Recoleta, the National Museum of Fine Arts and the Nuestra Señora del Pilar Basilica. The protagonist of the "porteño" night is, without questions, Palermo Soho, with its sophisticated design and deco stores, alternative art galleries, and thematic bars, ethnic and fusion-cuisine restaurants. **Dinner** included at La Cabaña restaurant or a similar, including a starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea, soda, juice, mineral water or a beer, and a glass of wine. Accommodation.

#### **Day 04 – Buenos Aires:**

Breakfast. After breakfast, **Shopping Time!** Buenos Aires is an ideal city to go shopping: Argentinian design is internationally known by its quality and innovation, and the exchange rate is incredibly good for visitors. After assessing your style and expectations, our bilingual tour guide will take us to the stores that best suit your style and needs. **Shopping Tour: Argentine Art:** You'll be joined by a bilingual tour guide, expert in Argentine art, who will offer you a detailed overview of art in Argentina from the 19th century to the present, and take you to the most renowned galleries in Buenos Aires, where an art dealer will be more than happy to help you. Approximate duration: 4 hours. Included services: Bilingual Personal shopper. Transportation and transfers in a comfortable, top of the line vehicle. Uniformed driver. Brochure with extended information of the tour and Buenos Aires postcard! Free afternoon. **Dinner** included at Cabaña Las Lilas restaurant or a similar, including a starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea, soda, juice, mineral water or a beer, and a glass of wine. Accommodation.

#### **Day 05 – Buenos Aires:**

Full-day excursion in private service with bilingual guide to "**Paraná Delta & Río De La Plata: An unforgettable Trip**". It includes a **Boat Trip through the Delta and the Río de la Plata**. In **San Isidro**, we will visit the elegant historic center which is very well preserved. We will visit the neogothic-style San Isidro Labrador Cathedral built from 1895 to 1898 that displays works of art and relics; among them, a piece of the incorrupt body of Saint Isidore. Around the Cathedral, we will admire the splendid mansions that in the Argentinean golden years were the weekend residencies of the "porteño" elite, such as Anchorena House (today, San Juan el Precursor School) and Pueyrredón House, pompeian-style building from 1790 where a museum is currently working. Finally, we will go down the viewpoint of the Río de la Plata which will amaze us for its immensity. We will move to Tigre city, located in the mouth of the Paraná River Delta. It is an alluvial basin of 100,000 years formed by sediments deposited through time by the Paraná River, with an approximate extension of 750,000 hectares; i.e., approx. 500 kilometers by car. We will visit Paseo Victorica where the Tigre Club and Casino are located. In this elegant totally-restored building, the Municipal Museum of Fine Arts is nowadays open. After the guided visit around the museum that displays an important collection of Argentinean figurative art, we will enjoy an excellent lunch at the bank of the river at Acacia restaurant located in the exclusive Villa Julia Hotel. Back to Buenos Aires in an exclusive craft sailing across the Paraná Delta, we will be amazed at the lushness of the landscape. We will continue through the Delta until we reach the Río de la Plata, and before disembarking in Costanera Norte, we will have the unique opportunity of observing the whole city from the river. **Lunch** included at Villa Julia restaurant or a similar, including a starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea, soda, juice, mineral water or a beer, and a glass of wine. Accommodation.

#### **Day 06 - Buenos Aires – Córdoba :**

Breakfast. In due time, private transportation service to domestic airport with bilingual guide is offered to take the flight to **Cordoba City**. Arrival, Reception at the airport and private transportation service to the chosen hotel with bilingual guide. In the afternoon, we will enjoy the "**Visit to the City**" excursion in a private service with a bilingual guide. This excursion is a must for anyone who arrives at the city whatever



reason they may have. Along the visit, we will discover diverse aspects this city features. Different surprising contrasts can be constantly distinguished at every turn. The architectural colonial legacy, the modern buildings, the important commercial activity merge with the Córdoba's cultural tradition to offer the visitor a wide variety of options. Departing from the hotel in modern vehicles with a professional guide, we will arrive at San Martín Square from where we will walk around the historic and cultural center. We will visit the Cathedral, Cabildo (Town Hall), Obispo Mercedillo Chapel, Santa Catalina Convent, Jesuitic Crypt of the Old Novitiate, "Juan de Tejada" Religious Art Museum, Monserrat School, National University of Córdoba Rectorate, Company of Jesus Church, among other traditional sites. We will continue by car to Padres Capuchinos Church of neogothic style, to Nueva Córdoba Neighborhood, Sarmiento Park, Caraffa Museum, and University City; then to downtown until we reach Nuevo Centro Shopping Mall, where we will walk around if we have time. Then, we will visit Cerro de Las Rosas neighborhood, the football stadium Chateau Carreras, and Ferial Córdoba Complex. Return to the hotel. At night, **dinner** can be enjoyed at Villa Agur restaurant or a similar one, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer. (It includes hotel/restaurant/hotel private transportation service). Accommodation.

#### **Day 07 - Córdoba City:**

Breakfast. Day at leisure. At night, **dinner** can be enjoyed at Della Fontana restaurant or a similar one, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer. (It includes hotel/restaurant/hotel private transportation service). Accommodation.

#### **Day 08 - Córdoba City - Ascochinga:**

This day, we will enjoy the "Road to the Jesuitic Ranches" full-day excursion in a private service with a bilingual guide. In the morning, we will depart from the hotel towards the north to visit the tourist sites of Río Ceballos, Salsipuedes, and El Manzano. Then, we will visit Ascochinga city. Slightly undulated area with lush vegetation. Next is the Sacred Heart of Jesus Chapel. 15 kilometers to the north, the next visit is Santa Catalina Jesuitic Ranch and Church. We will reach Jesús María where we will have lunch. **Lunch** included in La Casa del Friuli Trattoria in Jesús María or a similar one, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer. We will visit the following sites: National Jesuitic Museum of Jesús María, a ranch that was acquired by the Jesuits in 1618. Martín Fierro Doma and Folklore Amphitheater: Site where significant the Doma y Folklore National Festival is carried out every January. Colonia Coroya: Locality of Italian immigrants, it is famous for its cold cut, preserve, and jam production. Caroya House: Site where the first factory of cold weapons of the country was inaugurated in 1815. There, General San Martín and General Belgrano used to stay. Nowadays, it is a handicrafts and colonization museum. We will continue to Estancia La Paz that offer **half-board** accommodation. **Dinner** included at the ranch, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer.

#### **Day 09 - Ascochinga:**

Breakfast. Day at leisure. **Half-board** Accommodation. **Dinner** included at the ranch, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer.

#### **Day 10 - Ascochinga - Alta Gracia:**

This day, we will enjoy the "Punilla Valley" full-day excursion in a private service with a bilingual guide. We will depart from Estancia La Paz to the west via Ascochinga to visit Cruz Chica, Cruz Grande, and La Cumbre city so as to arrive at Los Cocos where we will visit the chairlift, the labyrinth, and the museum (optional access). Next is Capilla del Monte. We will visit the city and surroundings to admire the Uritorco Hill, Calle Techada (roofed street), and Zapato, a characteristic stony formation. We will continue to south to visit Villa Giardino where we will have lunch. **Lunch** included in Della Fontana Restaurant in Villa Giardino or a similar one, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer. After lunch, we will tour around the picturesque Punilla hills heading to Huerta Grande and La Falda. In La Falda, we will take a city tour to continue the circuit to the south where we will visit Valle Hermoso, Cosquín – venue of National Folklore Festival – and Biale Massé. We will reach the San Roque Dike wall. Brief stop to admire this important work, its outlet, and the impressive view of the lake and bordering the San Roque Lake we will arrive at Carlos Paz Village. Walk around the city and we will continue to Alta Gracia where we will stay at Howard Johnson Hotel & Casino Sierras that offers **half-board** accommodation. **Dinner** included at the hotel, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer.



### **Day 11 - Alta Gracia:**

Breakfast. Day at leisure. **Half-board** Accommodation. **Dinner** included at the hotel, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer.

### **Day 12 - Alta Gracia - Córdoba City - Buenos Aires:**

In due time, private transportation service to Córdoba City airport with bilingual guide is offered to take the flight to **Buenos Aires**. Arrival at domestic airport and transfer to the international airport to take the returning flight to the USA. **END of services.**
