



## Program USH04 (6 days/5 nights)

### Daily Itinerary

#### Day 01 – Ushuaia:

Reception at the airport and private transportation service to the chosen hotel with bilingual guide. In the afternoon, we will enjoy " **Visit to the City**" Excursion, in a private service with a bilingual guide, including visits to the " **End of the World Museum**", the " **Marine Museum and Prison of Ushuaia**", and to the " **Chairlift**". The city is located on the coast of the Beagle Channel surrounded by the Martial Mounts and its combination of mountains, sea, glaciers, and forest which offer us a unique landscape. We leave the local harbor through Maipú avenue to the Luis Pedro Figue walkway, we cross this narrow path that leads us to the La Mision neighborhood, location chosen by the first white men who settled in the area. Other neighborhoods are Brown and Solier, inhabited by the first immigrants who came at the beginning and middle of the century. Along the journey, we will see old houses belonging to the first Fueguinas families such as the Bebans, Cangas, Pastorizas, Fiques, Ramos, and the Provincial Legislative building, former Government building. We will also see the blasting growth produced by the arrival of the new inhabitants since the 80's. The tour includes transportation to the base of the chairlift of Le Martial Glacier with its waving path that will allow us to enjoy a beautiful landscape from the heights. Subject to weather conditions, we will do some trekking in the area of the base of the chairlift. The return trip is through Alem Avenue and it continues at the Marine Museum and former Ushuaia Prison, after a short visit we will continue with the End of the World Museum where we will enjoy a large part of the past of Tierra del Fuego. At night, **dinner** can be enjoyed at Chez Manú restaurant or a similar one, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer (It includes hotel/restaurant/hotel private transportation service). Accommodation.

#### Day 02 – Ushuaia:

This day, we will enjoy a full-day excursion to the " **Escondido and Fagnano Lakes**" in a private service with a bilingual guide. We will leave Ushuaia city via the National Route No. 3 (Pan-American) to the north of the island so as to access the Andes Fueguinos through the valleys covered by peat lands. We will tour around the Carbajal valleys, the Huskies, Tierra Mayor, and the Cotorras where visitors can practice cross-country skiing in winter. The next destination of the excursion will be Paso Garibaldi (450 meters above the sea level) where we will cross the Andes Mountain Range with the amazing scenery of Escondido and Fagnano Lakes. From there, we will start going down and then we will visit Petrel inn on the shore of Escondido Lake and we will continue until we reach the area of the sawmills, in particular the Martinez sawmill, currently abandoned, on the Fagnano Lake shore from where we will start our return trip to the city. Before, we will stop for **lunch** and we will try the typical Fueguino lamb "asado", included in the Morada del Águila restaurant at Castor Hill or a similar one, including starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer. Accommodation.

#### Day 03 – Ushuaia:

Breakfast. After breakfast, private transportation service with bilingual guide is offered to the " **Ushuaia Golf Club**" golf course, 1<sup>st</sup> golf round, green fee included. After the round, private transportation service with bilingual guide to Patagonia Mía restaurant or a similar one, which includes starter, main course, dessert, coffee or tea and soda or juice, mineral water or a beer. After lunch, we will go on an excursion in private service with a bilingual guide to the " **Tierra del Fuego National Park**", which is located 11 kilometers from the city. Within its borders, we will enjoy the lakes, lagoons, rivers, and its flow into the Beagle Channel, which makes it different from the other national parks in our country. We will start with the station of the **Train of the End of the World** and after a short visit to its facilities we will go by train through parts of the old railway of the prison train. We will cross bridges and peat lands and we will stop by the La Macarena waterfall. We will continue our journey entering into the Tierra del Fuego National Park towards the location of the train station of Route N° 3, where we will end our train journey. We will continue through the Pipo river valley up to the diversion to go into Ensenada Bay where we will be able to see the Redonda and Estorbo Islands and on the Beagle coast the Nevados Mount of the Sampaio Chain (Chile). We will go to the extreme area of the Park where the National Route N° 3 ends, in Lapataia Bay; at this point of the route we will see the Green Lagoon and the Black Lagoon, outstanding peat lands in process of formation. We will finish traveling along the beavers' dam, which path will lead us to the Lapataia Bay. Back

to Route N° 3, through a narrow path at which edges we will see different flora species, we will arrive at Roca Lake and do some trekking, bordering its coasts and the banks of Lapataia river, its natural end flow. From this location, we will see the Condor Hill, which peak enters the border with Chile. Accommodation.

**Day 04 – Ushuaia:**

Breakfast. After breakfast, private transportation service with bilingual guide is offered to the “Ushuaia Golf Club” golf course, 2<sup>nd</sup> golf round, green fee included. After the round, private transportation service with bilingual guide is offered to the hotel. Free afternoon. Accommodation.

**Day 05 – Ushuaia:**

Depending on the day of the week (**tuesdays, thursdays and saturdays**) in the morning, we will get on board to take the “Navigation to Harberton” (**including Penguin Rookery**) in the company of a private bilingual guide throughout the whole excursion. We leave the tourist dock to the southeast, navigating the waters of the Ushuaia Bay, with the city’s frame to the rear. Once at the center of the Beagle Channel, we will find the archipelago where the Alicia Island is inhabited by an important colony of imperial cormorants. Along the excursion, we will have the opportunity of watching the majestic eyebrow albatrosses, squas, and different seagull varieties, without forgetting the funny Vapor ducks or Alakush. Our excursion will continue to the east through the channel and we will head towards Les Eclaireurs Archipelago. In this archipelago, we will find Los Lobos Island. Here we will watch the two sea lions species typical of the channel (South American sea lions). On one of the other islands, we will find a lighthouse which was built under the same name of the archipelago. It was precisely in this area that in 1930 the Cervantes’s cruiser sank. Always heading to the east, we will navigate along the coasts of Almanza Harbor (Argentina) and Williams Harbor (Chile) to enter the Mackinlay Passage and continue to the Martillo Island, where we will see the elegant Magellanic penguins. Then, we will visit the Harberton Ranch, where we will enjoy a planned tour around its historic sites. Once we finish there, we will get on board to continue the return trip to Ushuaia along the waving Guarani Passage. At the end of this passage, we will find a small town Almanza Harbor where its few inhabitants are devoted to king crab fishing and salmon breeding. or (**mondays, wednesdays, fridays and sundays**) in the afternoon, we will get on board to take the “Navigation to Penguin Rookery” (**same itinerary but do not include Harberton**). Accommodation.

**Day 06 – Ushuaia:**

Breakfast. In due time, private transportation service to the airport with bilingual guide is offered to take the return flight. **END of services.**
